Class Descriptions:

Wee Thrive classes take inspiration from Waldorf and Montessori teachings offering an instructor-led environment with an emphasis on songs, stories, crafts, socialization, and early elementary basics.

Self-Directed STEAM classes offer a variety of enrichment and academic activities where students lead the way in what they want to do and learn each day. Our classes offer daily STEAM *Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, and Math* activities.

Middle School Hands-On STEAM utilizes a project-based approach with these older students. It is a student-centered, yet instructor-guided, approach where participants gain a deeper understanding of subjects through hands-on projects and real-world problem-solving and challenges.

Hands-On STEAM is an instructor-led class providing opportunities for experimentation, fun, learning, and exploring new concepts relating to *Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, and Math*.

Nature Connections is a life science class out in our beautiful Bidwell Park and in our garden here at Thrive.

The Teen Junior Leadership program is designed to give older teens experience in working with the younger children at Thrive alongside our Team Leaders. This gives them valuable lessons in responsibility and care-taking for others. The time and schedule will be determined by the teen, parent, and program coordinator - not to exceed two class times per week.
